Re: Food Additive Risk Assessment of Decafino Caffeine Reduction Pouches

Dear Mr. Liu:

The food additive risk assessment for the Decafino caffeine reduction pouch is attached.

Most all ingredients in the manufacture of the Decafino caffeine reduction pouch are Generally Recognized as Safe (GRAS) by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Only one of the ingredients (Methylcellulose) is defined by the FDA as a food additive (21 CFR 172.874).

On review of the composition and manufacturing process for Decafino and the FDA regulations it was determined that all the components of Decafino meet current FDA regulations for their intended use. When Decafino is manufactured and used according to good manufacturing practices, it does not pose a health risk to the consumer.
